4. What is one thing you had to practice in order to get stronger or better? How did the little improvements make you feel?

5. Even though Jessica has made great strides she is still feeling defeated. Have you ever felt this way? Who or what encouraged you to continue?

6. Why would Jessica fill out the service dog application? What clues do the illustrations provide?

7. Do you have a pet at home? If so, what kind and how did you get it?

8. Why is Rescue nervous to meet Jessica?

9. It's clear that Rescue can offer the support Jessica needs but what does he need in order to be happy and healthy? Is any of that different for a service dog?

10. How does Rescue lying next to Jessica make her feel better about the loss of her second leg? Has a pet or family member ever helped you through sadness?

11. Have you ever had a setback and what did you do to overcome it? How and why does this "restart" look different for Jessica?


12. What does it mean for someone to have a disability? Why is it important to understand different types of disabilities?


